The last four digits of the social security number is not required when you apply on behalf of a foster child or you list a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) case number or other FDPIR identifier for your child or when you indicate that the adult household member signing the application does not have a social security number. We will use your information to determine if your child is eligible for free or reduced price meals, and for administration and enforcement of the lunch and breakfast programs. We MAY share your eligibility information with education, health, and nutrition programs to help them evaluate, fund, or determine benefits for their programs, auditors for program reviews, and law enforcement officials to help them look into violations of program rules.

In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.

INSTRUCTIONS TO LOCAL AGENCY OFFICIALS:

When making a determination, the frequency of the current income is compared to the respective income eligibility guidelines (IEG) scale above. For example, weekly income is compared to the weekly scale above. Use the following procedures:

- If a household has only one income source, or if all sources are the same frequency, do not use conversion factors. Compare the income or the sum of the incomes to the published IEG for appropriate frequency and household size to make the eligibility determination.
- If a household reports income sources at more than one frequency, bring all income to annual by multiplying weekly income by 52, income received every 2 weeks by 26, income received twice a month by 24, and income received monthly by 12.
 - Do not round the values resulting from each conversion.
 - Add the sources of income together and compare to the scale above.

Instructions for farm/self-employed people are included in parent letter and the guidance for completing the application.

The agency should verify all questionable applications.

These guidelines are based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines annually.

Families must apply for meal benefits each year.
